This inquiry should aim to ascertain:


1. The extent to which the terms of these agreements have been adhered to by all parties involved.

Such an inquiry is essential not only for ensuring accountability and safeguarding the interests of our citizens but also for strengthening public trust in our government's financial management practices.


We respectfully request that this matter be given due consideration, and we stand ready to provide any assistance or support necessary to facilitate the inquiry process.
